Dear North Division Player and Parents,

Welcome to the North Division's 2017 season--our 65th year!

Please check out our web site listed above. During the year we post game summaries and pictures. You will find information that outlines various events and dates during the season. We have also enhanced our web page to include a Facebook Fan page and a Twitter feed.

Our annual Registration/Uniform Distribution Night is scheduled for THURSDAY, April 13, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Peabody School Cafeteria, 70 Rindge Avenue, North Cambridge. At the Registration Night we will distribute team uniforms and picture order forms. You can find our games schedules on the web.

To avoid delays at registration. Please bring the following on April 13th Registration Night:

- 1) **The 2017 Injury Release/Registration Form (one per player)**
- 2) **A copy of the player's birth certificate attached to the Injury Release/Registration Form, if this is your first year in the league**
- 3) **Registration Fee:** The registration fee is **\$75.00 per player (\$45 for each additional player)**. It is the policy of the League that every child will be allowed to play no matter what his/her financial circumstances. If your family wishes to request a full or partial waiver of the registration fee, please talk to Kellie DeJong, David Taylor or me on registration night. **YOU CAN GO TO OUR WEB SITE AND PAY ONLINE. ***If you are paying by check, please make your check payable to the North Cambridge Little Baseball League (NCLBL). Please write one check per player.**

Equipment/Safety Reminders – The North Division provides quality equipment to each team. However, it is highly recommended that you provide your child an athletic supporter, baseball cleats (rubber/plastic), mouth/teeth guard and batting gloves, in addition to a quality baseball (fielding) glove. Also, please provide your child water or other beverages to keep him/her hydrated during practices or games. Players should wear a sweatshirt under their uniform and bring a jacket to games or practices. This is especially important at the beginning of the season when it can become very chilly as the evening progresses.

Please be sure to spread the word to any players not currently in our program that our Farm League begins on **Saturday, April 22, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. at Comeau & Samp Fields on Rindge Avenue.**

As with all volunteer organizations, we can always use additional help, umpires, or sponsors. On the back page there is a form with details on how you can volunteer. Please complete and return to the individuals listed below on Registration Night.
