Where can Cambridge boys and girls learn teamwork, develop self-confidence, practice discipline and hard work, and have a lot of fun?

The North Division is not only the place, but for over 65 years, our youth baseball program has made important differences in the lives of almost 200 children every season.

Every spring, we offer a Farm League program for boys and girls seven years old and younger, a sixteen game schedule for our five Minor League teams, and four Major League teams. After the regular season, we sponsor a Play-off championship series, Mayor's Cup and All-Star Tournaments. In addition, Summer League All-Star teams from the North Division participate in the Bay State Baseball League that includes over 25 cities and towns from Eastern Massachusetts, as well as an intra-mural summer baseball program.

What makes North Division one of the oldest and most successful programs in Massachusetts?

A Dedicated Mission: To teach children important life skills through recreational sports.

Volunteer Commitment: 40 volunteer coaches, averaging 100-150 hours per season- many with 10, 20 and even 30 plus years' experience!

Sponsor Support: Over 30 local businesses, churches, civic organizations, and the city provide annual financial support, including two sponsors who have supported us for over twenty-five years.

The Board of Directors oversees the annual budget for equipment, uniforms, insurance, umpires, and trophies. Even though the NCLBL has operated in the black for several years, there is an on-going need to improve the program and recruit new sponsors.
